## The World's Most Stunning Wineries

Sometimes it's a remote vineyard, steeply terraced high above a winding river. Sometimes it's an architect's extraordinary vision, manifested in curls of reflective metal. Sometimes it's a perfectly preserved duo of vast Renaissance fireplaces, one the face of a devil and one an angel. Whatever it might be that fixes a place in memory, these are the wineries that have those details. Each of the estates profiled here leaves no question that you've stopped at one of the most beautiful places on Earth—and a place that happens to make extraordinary wine as well.



### Viña Vik: Millahue Valley, Chile

Luxury hoteliers Alex and Carrie Vik landed on this remote valley in Chile for their eponymous winery in an attempt to create the best wine in South America. Whether they've succeeded at that is something other top wineries might question (though the **Vik wine** is indeed very good), but in the meantime they've created a stunning winery for it. A sloping plaza of streaming water strewn with granite boulders leads into the otherworldly winery building. Add the adjacent hotel with its rippling, bronzed-titanium roof and the whole property's visual effect is unforgettable.
