An art lover's adventure in Argentina

Buenos Aires is brought to life through its vibrant art scene on this curated four-day city tour

Art, travel and contemporary culture collide in Curagenda's inaugural *Art Basel Cities: Buenos Aires*, an immersive four-day **Argentinian** experience from September 6. The curated tour is limited to 30 people (\$2,400 per person, exclusive of travel and accommodation) and the itinerary customised for each individual as they explore the city's rich artistic history and culinary scene – and are introduced to the major movers of the **South American** art world.

Additional excursions to the **Viña Vik** retreat in **Chile**, and to Argentina's Estancia Colomé can also be arranged before the start of the Buenos Aires tour. At Viña Vik, guests will be treated to tours of the **winery** designed by celebrated Chilean architect Smiljan Radic, before retiring to art-filled rooms that have been carefully curated by owner-collectors, Alexander and Carrie Vik. Guests who choose to travel to Estancia Colomé in Argentina's Salta province will also enjoy unique access to the **James Turrell** Museum.
