Sublimity is a sought-after luxury asset, and the Viña VIK winery delivers it with a subtle combination of raw nature and illuminating technology, perfectly framing the landscape of the Andes.

: Clever design by Chilean architect Smiljan Radić allows water to flow over a slope in the vast entrance area to create natural cooling.

: Walkways cut into the space allow visitors to wander through a water-filled vista. The movement of the water creates a calming soundscape that fills the space below

: A transparent fabric roof makes up the roof of the winery, allowing natural sunlight to permeate the indoor space, saving the use of artificial lighting

: Fascinating glimpses of winemaking are seen in the subterranean winery
